In order to keep greens in great shape, they have to be aerated during the season. In the past, we have done this in the fall.

In 2010 we are moving it to June 28 & 29.

Doing so will allow the greens to heal much faster than performing the task in the fall. It will also help us complete the process more efficiently.

Ultimately, this will mean we will have better putting surfaces for our golfers all season long!

Adult Clinics

Each spring, Songbird Hills offers Adult Clinics to help golfers get into the swing of things. The clinics are targeted at both new golfers and those who want to brush up on the basics. Let us help you prepare for the upcoming golf season so you can have a great summer on the course!

The clinics consist of 2 sessions, each 2 hours long that cover the fundamentals of putting, chipping and the full swing.

The Clinic Fee is \$54.50 (incl. tax), which includes 4 hours of group instruction, as well as a pass for a 9 hole round of golf. The pass can be used upon mastering the golf swing, or completing the clinic, whichever comes first!

Junior Golf Program - 2010

Songbird Hills is proud to provide a great opportunity for junior golfers, promoting golf etiquette, skill development, fair play and the fun of playing the game of golf.

We also offer special golfing rates to juniors enrolled in our programs, discounting the green fees after noon, Mon.-Thurs., from June 14 until August 31.

• Beginner Program •

These lessons emphasize the basics of golf to juniors ages 7-12. Each hour-long Beginner lesson teaches the mechanics of using different golf clubs. The cost is \$55.00 for the five-week session, which includes instruction, an opportunity to play a few holes of golf & refreshments after the last lesson of the session.

• Intermediate Program & Golf •

Each of the Intermediate sessions includes a lesson followed by a supervised 9 hole round of golf. Intermediate golfers, ages 9-15, must have been in one of the SHGC junior programs in the past or must be able to score 70 or better for nine holes. The cost is \$83.00 for the five-week session, which includes the lessons, instructional materials, rounds of golf & a picnic on the last day of the session.

• Junior Golf League •

The Junior Golf League is aimed at 12 to 17 year olds interested in playing golf at a more competitive level.

The golfers play a 9-hole match each week. Golfers will be required to understand the rules of golf and scoring, and must be able to score in the 60's or lower for 9 holes. The cost is \$98.00 for the 8-week league. This includes the green fees, prize fee, & lunch on the last day of the league.
