Rules & Information

- All USGA Rules apply except when modified by Local Rules.
- Men shall play from the WHITE tees; Women & Juniors shall play from the RED tees.
- Prizes will be awarded for 1st & 2nd Place, as well as randomly drawn places thereafter.
- Event Format Definitions:
 - 2-Person Scramble - Both golfers hit a tee shot, decide which one to use for the next shot, then both golfers will hit the next shot from that place. Continue in this pattern until the ball is holed out. You'll have 1 team score per hole.
(Holes 1-6)
 - 2-Person Best-Ball - Both golfers will play their own ball the entire time and will use the lower score of the two golfers for the Team Score.
(Holes 7-12)
 - 2-Person Alt. Shot - Golfer 'A' will tee off on the odd numbered holes (13,15 & 17) and Golfer 'B' will tee off on the even numbered holes (14, 16 & 18). After teeing off, alternate hitting until the ball is holed out. You'll have 1 team score per hole.
(Holes 13-18)

More detailed rules will be distributed the day of the event.

- Lunch will be served after all golfers have completed their rounds.
